Venue Access Statement

Parking & Access between sites

No parking available at any of the venues.

Nearest parking at:

St Cuthbert's Way Carpark

Brunswick Street

Darlington

DL1 1TB

£3 all day. Private carpark.

Surface for bays – half carpark concrete – half carpark gravel.

Dropped kerb access between all sites.

Postcodes supplied to enable distance between venues to be calculated via google maps: www.google.co.uk/maps

Venue: Darlington Train Station, DL1 4AA

Exit via Victoria Road (underpass) for Hogans.

Exit via B6280 for all other venues.

Musicians will play on concourse.

Step free access throughout station and both exits.

Accessible toilets require radar key.

Venue: Forum Music Centre, entrance on Brunswick Street, DL1 1TB

Step free access. Ramp with handrail to access building.

Security will be on the door to assist if required.

All rooms used as venues and the toilets are step free and wheelchair accessible.

No dropped level bar.

No seating in main hall – pre-book if required.

Wheelchair users will take priority to be near to stage for viewing ease.

Cabaret style seating in Room 1 for comedy event. Chairs will be removed as required to allow wheelchair users to sit where they desire.

Accessible toilet – 91 cm wide door. Transfer space and rail. Red emergency cord.

Venue: St John the Evangelist Church, Neasham Road, DL1 4AD

3 steep large steps to access building. Security present on door will lay out ramp to enable wheelchair access. Curved and steep camber towards door.

Fixed pew seating in rows.

Wheelchair users will be seated near to stage for viewing ease.

There are no accessible toilets at this venue.

Toilets are accessed via one steep step – 18cm high.

Venue: Hogans, 180 Victoria Road, DL1 5JN

Upstairs venue. Steep flight of stairs. Plus steps to access building. No lift. No wheelchair access.

Venue: Theatre Hullabaloo, Borough Road, DL1 1SG

Security will be on the door to assist if required.

Level step free access throughout.

Automatic doors at entry.

Dropped level bar.

Accessible toilet. Transfer space and rail. Red emergency cord.
Two entrances to theatre – one via steps, one level and step free.
Double doors to access theatre space. Wheelchair users will be seated near to stage for viewing ease.
Seating.
